

Lisa went to a training facility in Florida for a week where she learned everything there is to know about lice and nits as well as opening a salon that specializes in the process. Lisa explained that most of her employees are moms who wanted to get back into the workplace. The salon is run on a "by appointment only" basis so her schedule, as well as her employees', is quite flexible.
